### Black Country Museum, Dudley



Black Country Living Museum is an award-winning open air museum that tells the story of one of the very first industrialised landscapes in Britain.

See history brought to life and discover the story of the Black Country at our open-air living museum. Meet our historic characters who'll show you what it was like to live and work in one of the first industrialised landscapes in Britain as you explore 26 acres of reconstructed shops, pubs and houses.

You'll learn how steam power, human ingenuity and an increasingly interconnected world transformed this region into a manufacturing powerhouse. Most importantly, you'll see history brought to life before your eyes – you'll hear the clang of hammers; smell the smoke billowing from red brick chimneys; and maybe even taste the best fish and chips in the world. There's plenty for all the family to see and do here. From watching live demonstrations, taking part in old fashioned street games, to visiting our vintage cinema and enjoying our traditional fish and chips, there's something for everyone at Black Country Living Museum. Walk in the footsteps of the Peaky Blinders show's biggest stars as you explore one of the key sets of the global smash hit drama.

### Blenheim Palace, Oxford



Home to the 12th Duke and Duchess of Marlborough and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill,, Blenheim Palace is a masterpiece of Baroque architecture that boasts over 300 years of history to discover. This World Heritage Site is set within more than 2000 acres of Parkland landscaped by 'Capability' Brown, and the Palace itself houses some of the finest collections of antique furniture in Europe. Situated in Woodstock, just 8 miles from Oxford, Blenheim Palace is Britain's Greatest Palace and offers visitors a precious time, every time.

Take the Miniature Train from the Palace for a little adventure in our Walled Garden or Explore the Butterfly House and Marlborough Maze at your own pace and find the new trail.

The maze is two miles in length and made up of hundreds of yew trees in a design inspired by the history of Blenheim Palace. The maze can provide hours of fun, depending on how long it takes you to find your way out!
